RE: Bondi Farms Pest Control Process

We here at Bondi Farms pride ourselves on having pesticide free product. Not only do we have thousands of customers who purchase and use our product, but many of those customers are our friends and family. So, we want only the safest can cleanest product we can provide.

So how do we control pest? Our main way is using beneficial/natural predators we believe this provides the safest and healthiest products. These natural predators include the following: Amblyseius Andersoni, Cucumeris, Amblyseius Fallacis, Californicus and Persimilis. While the bad pests attack the plants, these predators attack the bad pest. All these insects are microscopic. This is the same process that would happen naturally out in nature, but since we are an indoor garden we need to bring these beneficials in each week. Every week once we move plants into a flower room to start bud development we introduce a new round of beneficials. If at any point we have a problem with our flowering plants and the beneficials are not working on a particular plant or two, then we just kill and remove those plants from the room. We have thousands and thousands of plants in our warehouse it is important that our head grower remove any plant with issues as soon as possible. We also get consulting and our beneficials from Sound Horticulture. They have been a big help in our process for having clean flower for over 8 years.

As for the early stages of the plant we do use a couple organic sprays Bonide Sulfur Plant Fungicide and Green Cleaner Fungicide that are approved by the WSDA or Washington State Department of Agriculture. These are topical in nature and are not absorbed by the plant unlike some other sprays. These are the same type of sprays that can and are used on different fruits and vegetables. These are approved to be applied throughout the entire life of the plant, but that is not how we use them. If we used them in flowering, they would also kill our beneficials and defeat everything we do to prevent pesticide free products. As for nutrients, we use General Hydroponic the Flora series. All our plants our grown in soil and are hand watered.
